

Personally Referable Information

When there is a possibility that a third party will receive personally referable information (limited to that which constitutes a personally referable information database, etc.) in the form of personal data, the Company will not provide such personally referable information to said third party without confirming the following in advance.

(1) That the consent of the individual concerned has been obtained to allow the third party to receive the personally referable information from the Company and acquire it as personal data that can identify the individual concerned.

(2) That in the event of provision to a third party located in a foreign country, when the consent of the individual specified in the preceding item is to be obtained, the system concerning the protection of personal information in said foreign country, the measures taken by said third party to protect personal information, and other information relevant to the individual concerned have been provided to said individual in advance.
